Full Days in Nursery			
Parents should note that our full day provision runs from 8.30am to 3.30pm, resulting in our 2 ½ day provision and 5 day provision exceeding the 15 and 30 hour free entitlement limits set by government. We make a charge of £4.00 per day to cover the cost of supervision for the additional hour per day that children receive when they spend a full day with us. This includes the cost of a school lunch which we serve between 11.30am and 12.30pm. Parents may pay this weekly in advance via our online payment system, School Gateway. Details on how to set up an account will be sent after your child's place is confirmed.
